FLYING INSECT EXTERMINATOR GENERAL INFORMATION



These instructions are intended for the USER.

Read the warnings they contain carefully since they provide important guidance for safe installation, use and maintenance.

KEEP THESE INSTRUCTIONS IN A SAFE PLACE FOR FURTHER CONSULTATION.

1 - OPERATION

The insects are attracted by the ultraviolet light emitted by the special lamp. They are then electrocuted by the electrified grid and fall into an easily emptied tray.

2 - SAFETY

Before connecting the device, check that the nameplate specifications give the same ratings as the mains power supply and that the connection socket is protected by a differential security breaker.

If the plug on the device power supply lead does not fit into the mains socket, have the socket replaced by a qualified electrician.

Also make sure that the socket wires are of suitable gauge for the exterminator's power absorption.

This device must only be used for the purpose for which it was expressly designed. Any other use must be considered improper and thus hazardous. The constructor may not be held responsible for any damage deriving from improper, incorrect or unreasonable use.

A number of fundamental rules must be observed when using any electrical device. In particolar:

- REMOVE THE PLUG FROM THE MAINS SOCKET BEFORE ANY MAINTENANCE WORK.
- NEVER TOUCH THE DEVICE WITH WET HANDS AND BARE FEET
- NEVER PULL THE POWER LEAD OR THE DEVICE ITSELF TO DISCONNECT THE PLUG FROM THE MAINS SOCKET.
- NEVER IMMERSE THE DEVICE IN WATER AND NEVER CLEAN IT BY SPRAYING IT WITH WATER.

3 - ASSEMBLY

Remove the packaging and make sure that nothing is left inside the box (particularly the hanging chains and insect collection tray).


The device is normally hung from the ceiling using the hanging chains provided at a height of about 3 metres above the ground, protected from draughts.


4 - MAINTENANCE


Extract the tray to remove dead insects.

The grid and lamp can be clean using a cloth or brush.

IMPORTANT - THIS DEVICE MUST NOT BE USED OUTDOORS.







REPLACING THE LAMPS

Before carrying out this operation, disconnect from the power supply by removing the plug, and extract the collection dish.

- 1. Remove the screws and black covers (see Fig. 1), then slide off the side covers.
- 2. Remove the black protection grids (see Fig. 2), then replace the lamps.
